

NATIONAL DEBT SINKING FUND.

No. 3 of 1925.

An Act to amend the *National Debt Sinking Fund Act 1923-1924*.

[Assented to 8th July, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *National Debt Sinking Fund Act 1925*. Short title and citation.
- (2.) The *National Debt Sinking Fund Act 1923-1924** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *National Debt Sinking Fund Act 1923-1925*.
2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of March One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five. Commencement.
3. Section nine of the Principal Act is amended— Payments to the Sinking Fund.
- (a) by omitting from paragraph (c) of sub-section (1.) thereof the words “or (f) of this sub-section” and inserting in their stead the words “, (f), (g) or (h) of this sub-section, and under section nine A of this Act”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (e) of sub-section (1.) thereof the word “and” (last occurring); and
- (c) by inserting after paragraph (f) of sub-section (1.) thereof the following paragraphs:—
- “ (g) all moneys received in respect of reparations under the Treaty of Peace with Germany; and
- (h) all moneys received from the States as Sinking Fund contributions in respect of loans made by the Commonwealth to the States.”

4. After section nine of the Principal Act the following section is inserted :—

Additional
payment to the
Sinking Fund.

“ 9A. The Treasurer may in any financial year pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated for the purpose, into the National Debt Sinking Fund such sum as he may determine in addition to those specified in the last preceding section.”.

5. Section eleven of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is inserted in its stead :—

Appropriation
of money.

“ 11. All moneys payable into the National Debt Sinking Fund in pursuance of sub-section (1.) of section nine of this Act, excepting moneys payable in pursuance of paragraphs (d), (e), (f), (g) and (h) of that section, shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated for the purpose.”.

EXPORT GUARANTEE.

No. 4 of 1925.

An Act to amend Section Five of the *Export Guarantee Act 1924*.

[Assented to 8th July, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

Short title and
citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Export Guarantee Act 1925*.

(2.) The *Export Guarantee Act 1924** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Export Guarantee Act 1924-1925*.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of the commencement of the Principal Act.
