(b) in respect of cotton yarn manufactured in Australia and delivered from a factory on or before the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two:

Provided that, in any particular case, bounty shall, with the approval of the Minister, be payable in respect of lint produced, on or before the thirtieth day of September One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, from Australian-grown seed cotton, instead of in respect of the seed cotton from which the lint is produced.".

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act (No. 1) 1932-33.

Short title.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards Issue and making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the \$3,921,845. service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three the sum of three million nine hundred and twenty-one thousand eight hundred and forty-five pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.
