SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION

1922-23.

No. 58 of 1924.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.

[Assented to 20th October, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Short title Act 1922-23.
- 2. The sum of One million three hundred and forty-nine Appropriation of £1,349,608. thousand six hundred and eight pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twentythree shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 42 of 1922 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
