

SCIENCE AND INDUSTRY APPROPRIATION.

No. 27 of 1928.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Scientific and Industrial Investigation.

[Assented to 22nd June, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble.
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Science and Industry Appropriation Act 1928*. Short title.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Science and Industry Research Act 1920-1926*, and known as the Science and Industry Investigation Trust Account, the sum of Two hundred and fifty thousand pounds. Appropriation of £250,000 for scientific and industrial research.

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 1926-27.

No. 28 of 1928.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.

[Assented to 28th June, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble.
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1926-27*. Short title.

Appropriation
of £973,779.

2. The sum of nine hundred and seventy-three thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 28 of 1927 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
