

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) 1920-1921.

No. 43 of 1921.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble.
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation* Short title.
(*Works and Buildings*) Act 1920-1921.

2. The sum of Thirty-four thousand four hundred and sixty-six pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 26 of 1920 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act. Appropriation of £34,466.
