SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) 1931-1932.

Act No. 11 of 1933.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 24th July, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation (Works and Buildings) Act 1931-1932.*

Short title.

2. The sum of Two hundred and nine thousand pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two shall be deemed to have been

AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF ANATOMY AGREEMENT.

Act No. 12 of 1933.

An Act to amend the *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1924-1931.*

[Assented to 24th July, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1933.*

(2.) The *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1924-1931* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Australian Institute of Anatomy Agreement Act 1924-1933.*

2. After section three of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Agreements in relation to donations

“4. The Treasurer may enter into an Agreement in regard to any sum of money which may be contributed for any purpose connected with the Australian Institute of Anatomy, and may appoint one or more trustees to secure the accomplishment of the purpose.”

An Act to amend the *Commerce (Trade Descriptions) Act 1905-1930* and for other purposes.

[Assented to 24th July, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Commerce (Trade Descriptions) Act 1933.*
