No. 40 of 1935.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for а sum Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 25th October, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions short title. Appropriation Act 1935.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act* 1901–1934, and known Pensions. as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Twelve million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA GRANT.

No. 42 of 1935.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the purposes of Financial Assistance to the State of South Australia.

[Assented to 25th October, 1935.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the South Australia Grant Act 1935.

2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance to the State of South Australia, during the year commencing on the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, the sum of One million five hundred thousand pounds.

3. The amount payable under this Act shall be paid in equal monthly instalments.

4. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.
