

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND SERVICES) 1953-54.

No. 26 of 1955.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, for the purposes of Additions, New Works and Other Services involving Capital Expenditure.

[Assented to 15th June, 1955.]

[Date of commencement, 13th July, 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation (Works and Services) Act 1953-54.* Short title.

2. The sum of Seven hundred and twenty-one thousand nine hundred and fourteen pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act. Appropriation of £721,914.
