An Act to repeal the Excise Duty on Sugar.

[ Assented to 24th December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Sugar Excise Repeal Act 1912. Short title.
- 2. This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation. commencement.
- 3. The Excise Tariff 1905 (No. 24 of 1905), the Excise Tariff Repeal of Sugar (Amendment) 1906 (No. 15 of 1906), and the Excise (Sugar)Act 1910 (No. 17 of 1910), are hereby repealed.
