BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

and citation. | <p>1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the <i>Stevedoring Industry Charge Act 1956</i>.</p> <p>(2.) The <i>Stevedoring Industry Charge Act 1947-1954</i>* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.</p> <p>(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the <i>Stevedoring Industry Charge Act 1947-1956</i>.</p> |
| Commencement | <p>2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirtieth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.</p> |
| Rate of charge. | <p>3. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "Six pence" and inserting in their stead the words "One shilling and sevenpence".</p> |
| Application of
amendment. | <p>4. The Principal Act as amended by this Act applies in relation to the employment of waterside workers on and after the date of commencement of this Act.</p> |
