
SUGAR REBATE ABOLITION.

No. 3 of 1903.

An Act to abolish the Rebate of Excise Duty on
Sugar.

[Assented to 30th July, 1903.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Sugar Rebate Abolition Act* 1903.

Abolition of
rebate.

2. The Schedule to the *Excise Tariff* 1902 is hereby amended by
the omission of the provision for a rebate of excise duty on sugar.

No further rebate
to be paid.

3. After the commencement of this Act no such rebate as afore-
said shall be paid to any grower of sugar-cane or beet, and no rebate
note for any such rebate shall be issued.
