TRUST FUND ADVANCES.

No. 2 of 1910.

An Act to authorize a temporary advance from the Trust Fund to the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

[Assented to 6th August, 1910.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Trust Fund Advances Act 1910.

Advance from the Trust Fund 2. There may be advanced as on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and ten from the Trust Fund for the purposes of revenue an amount not exceeding Five hundred thousand pounds.

Crediting of advance.

3. The amount so advanced shall be credited to the several States in proportion to the numbers of their people.

Repayment of advance.

4. The amount so advanced shall be repaid to the Trust Fund on or before the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and eleven, and the Consolidated Revenue Fund is hereby appropriated for that purpose accordingly.
