SPECIAL ANNUITY.

No. 64 of 1934.

An Act to provide for the Payment of an Annuity to the Widow of the late David Charles McGrath, Esquire,

[Assented to 17th December, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Proamble and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Annuity Act 1934.

Short title:

2.—(1.) Subject to this Act, there shall be payable, out of the Annuity to widow of the solidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated later than the state of the later Decident McCrosth Flowing. D. C. McGraths Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, to the widow of the late David Charles McGrath, Esquire, sometime a member of the House of Representatives, an annuity at the rate of One hundred and fifty-six pounds per annum.

(2.) The annuity provided by this Act shall cease to be payable

in the event of the re-marriage of the annuitant.

TRANS-PACIFIC FLIGHT APPROPRIATION.

An Act to appropriate a sum of Five thousand pounds for the purpose of a Grant to Mrs. Mary Josephine Ulm.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Trans-Pacific Flight Appropriation short title. Act 1934.
- 2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, Appropriation. which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purpose of a grant to Mrs. Mary Josephine Ulm, the sum of Five thousand pounds.
