## WINE GRAPES CHARGES.

## No. 40 of 1954.

## An Act to amend the Wine Grapes Charges Act 1929-1941.

[Assented to 29th October, 1954.] [Date of commencement, 26th November, 1954.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Wine Grapes Charges Act Short title and citation 1954.

(2.) The Wine Grapes Charges Act 1929-1941,\* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Wine Grapes Charges Act 1929-1954.

2. Section three of the Wine Grapes Charges Act 1929-1941 is Charge on amended-

grapes used for wine making

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-section (2.) the words "five shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "Ten shillings"; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section (2.) the words "fifteen shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "One pound ten shillings".
