Justice Legislation Amendment (Miscellaneous) Bill 2023

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to make various amendments to the following Acts and regulations relating to courts, crimes and other Communities and Justice portfolio matters—

- (g) the *Civil Procedure Act 2005*,
- (h) the *Civil Procedure Regulation 2017*,
- (i) the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Act 2000*,
- (j) the *Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Regulation 2014*,
- (k) the *Crimes (High Risk Offenders) Act 2006*,
- (l) the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*,
- (m) the *Criminal Procedure Regulation 2017*,
- (n) the *Dormant Funds Act 1942*,
- (o) the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*,

- (p) the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*,
- (q) the *Fines Act 1996*,
- (r) the *NSW Trustee and Guardian Act 2009*,
- (s) the *Terrorism (High Risk Offenders) Act 2017*,
- (t) the *Terrorism (Police Powers) Act 2002*.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

Schedules 1–6 contain amendments to the Acts and regulations specified in the overview and explanatory notes for the amendments.
