

**NATIONAL PARKS AND WILDLIFE (ADJUSTMENT OF AREA)
BILL, 1984**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The objects of this Bill are to provide for the excision from Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park, and for the vesting in the Commissioner for Main Roads, of—

- (a) certain land comprising about 27 hectares between Cowan and Berowra on which part of the Sydney to Newcastle Freeway and associated works are constructed; and
- (b) certain land comprising about 99 hectares between Wahroonga and a point north of Berowra required for or in connection with the construction of a part of the Sydney to Newcastle Freeway and associated works.

The Bill contains the following provisions:—

Clause 1. Short title.

Clause 2. Interpretation.

Clause 3 excises from Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park land required or used for or in connection with the construction of a part of the Sydney to Newcastle Freeway and associated works.

Clause 4 vests the lands excised under clause 3 in the Commissioner for Main Roads.

Schedule 1 contains a description of the land referred to in clause 3.
