A BILL

To amend the Cattle Slaughtering and Diseased Animals and Meat Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Slaughtering and Diseased Animals and Meat (Amendment) Act, 1929." Short title.

2. The Cattle Slaughtering and Diseased Animals and Meat Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting next after subsection four of section fifteen the following new subsections :—

(5) Any proclamation made in pursuance of the powers conferred by this section may apply—

(a) generally to the whole State or particularly to the portion or portions of the State specified in the proclamation ;

(b) generally to all cattle or skins, or particularly to the class or classes of cattle or of skins specified in the proclamation.

(6) A proclamation under this section shall, before being made, be submitted to the Board of Health, and the proclamation shall not be made unless the said board approves of its provisions.
