A BILL

To amend section one hundred and twenty-one of the Child Welfare Act, 1923, in relation to the payment of expenses incurred in respect of the administration of that Act; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Child Welfare Short title. Amendment (Expenses of Administration) Act, 1928," and shall be read with the Child Welfare Act, 1923, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to commence on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.

2. The Child Welfare Act, 1923, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from section one hundred and twenty-one all the words following the words "for that purpose".
