## A BILL

To provide for the necessary amendment of certain Acts, proclamations, and other instruments and documents, consequent upon the alteration in designation of the Minister for Labour and Industry ; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Ministry for Labour Act, 1921."

**2.** (1) Wherever in any Act, proclamation, regulation, rule, by-law, order, appointment, instrument, or document in force on the seventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, the words "Labour and Industry" appear as part of the designation or title of the Minister for Labour and Industry, or of the Department of Labour and Industry, or of any officer of the Department of Labour and Industry, the said Act, proclamation, regulation, rule, by-law, order, appointment, instrument, or document shall, as from the said date, be read and construed as if the words "and Industry" were omitted therefrom respectively. 5 10

(2) Nothing hereinbefore contained shall prejudice any powers of repeal, cancellation, amendment, variation, or alteration, which might, if this Act had not been passed, be exercised in relation to any such proclamation, regulation, rule, by-law, order, appointment, instrument, or document as aforesaid. 15
