## A BILL

'To enable Senators and Members of the House of Representatives of the Parliament of the Commonwealth to sit and vote in and be elected to the present Parliament of New South Wales.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Members of Parliament Short title.  
Enabling Act, 1900."

2. Nothing in the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Members of Federal Parliament may sit and vote in Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly.  
Act shall be taken to constitute the office of Senator or Member of the House of Representatives of the Parliament of the Commonwealth an office of profit so as to render such Senator or Member incapable of sitting or voting as a Member of the Legislative Council or Legislative Assembly of New South Wales during the continuance of the present Parliament of New South Wales, or to render void the election of any Member of the said Legislative Assembly during such continuance.
