A BILL

To make provision for the reduction of
harbour and light rates on certain ships;
for this purpose to amend section sixty-one
of the Navigation Act, 1901-1935; and for
purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
5 the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Navigation
(Amendment) Act, 1939."

(2) The Navigation Act, 1901-1935, as amended by
subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the
10 Navigation Act, 1901-1939.

Navigation (Amendment).

2. The Navigation Act, 1901-1935, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section sixty-one the words "of fourpence per ton" and by inserting in lieu thereof the following words "as follows:—
