A BILL

To amend the Neglected Children and Juvenile
Offenders Act, 1905.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Neglected Short title.
Children and Juvenile Offenders Amendment Act,
1916."

2. Section five of the Neglected Children and Amendment
of definition
of "neglected
child."
Juvenile Offenders Act, 1905, is amended as follows:—
In the definition of "neglected child," paragraph (j)
is omitted, and the following paragraph inserted
in lieu thereof:—

- (j) Who is living in such conditions as would be
likely to cause the child to lead a vicious or
immoral life, or to tend to the commission of
crime.
