BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 69, 1973 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

GENERAL.

Variation of authorized expenditure from Consolidated Revenue Fund.

- 36. (1) Subject to section thirty-four of the Audit Act, 1902, and subsection two of this section, expenditure shall not be incurred on any item, subdivision, division, or vote, shown on the Estimates of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in excess of the sum provided therefor on such Estimates.
- (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any item, subdivision, or division other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services", to any other item, subdivision, or division, within the same vote other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services".

Variation of authorized expenditure from other Funds.

- 37. (1) Subject to subsection two of this section, expenditure shall not be incurred on any division shown on the Estimates of the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Maritime Services Board Fund, in excess of the sum provided therefor on such Estimates.
- (2) If the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or the person appointed by him may authorize the transfer of a specific amount from any division, other than for specific public works, to any other division within the vote other than for specific public works.

Provisions affecting sections thirty-seven and thirty-eight.

- 38. (1) Nothing in sections thirty-six and thirty-seven of this Act shall empower the Treasurer or the person appointed by him as aforesaid to authorize the transfer of any sum in augmentation of or as an addition to any salary or wages the amount of which has been fixed by law.
- (2) The Treasurer shall cause the Auditor-General to be informed of every authority granted pursuant to sections thirty-six and thirty-seven of this Act.

Treasurer or lawful authority shall pay by warrant or order. 39. There shall be issued and paid the said several sums for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the Treasurer or other lawful authority may from time to time order and direct, and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the said funds respectively; but the said Treasurer shall not be held liable for any claims which may arise in connection with any of the State Departments transferred to the Commonwealth on or after the date of such transfer.

40. The said Treasurer or other lawful authority shall in their No. 69, 1973 respective accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him or them in pursuance of such or lawful warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and the receipts of the authority respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full shall be and valid discharge to the said Treasurer or other lawful authority allowed in passing the said accounts for any such sums as may be therein moneys paid mentioned, and he or they shall receive credit for the same by them.
