An Act to sanction the carrying out of  
**Additions to the Treasury Building in  
 Macquarie-street, Sydney. [22nd Septem-  
 ber, 1896.]**

ADDITIONS TO  
 'TREASURY  
 BUILDING.

**W**HEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Public Preamble.  
 Works Act of 1888, the Legislative Assembly did, by reso-  
 lution, declare that it was expedient to carry out a certain work,  
 namely, Additions to the Treasury Building: And whereas on the  
 passing of the said resolution a statutory duty was by the said Act  
 imposed on the Secretary for Public Works to introduce a Bill into  
 the said Assembly to sanction the carrying out of the said work: Be  
 it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and  
 with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative  
 Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the  
 authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The carrying out of the said work (more particularly Work sanctioned.  
 described in the Schedule to this Act) is hereby sanctioned; and the  
 Secretary for Public Works, or the Member of the Executive Council  
 for the time being performing the duties of the said Secretary, is  
 hereby authorised to undertake and carry out the said work subject  
 to the provisions of this Act.

2. The plan of the said work is the plan marked "Additions Plan of work.  
 to the Treasury Building," signed by the Secretary for Public Works  
 and countersigned by the Government Architect, and deposited in the  
 public office of the said Secretary.

3. The cost of carrying out the said work, estimated at twenty- Cost, how to be  
 one thousand five hundred pounds, may be defrayed from such Loan  
 Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to that purpose, and  
 shall not under any circumstances exceed the estimated cost by more  
 than ten per centum.

4. This Act may be cited as the "Additions to Treasury Building Short title.  
 Act, 1896."

**SCHEDULE.**

The proposed work comprises the erection of a strong room with all appurte-  
 nances and appliances necessary; also the erection of a new building connecting the  
 said strong room with the existing Treasury Buildings for the accommodation of  
 Treasury officials.

It also comprises the necessary alterations to the existing Treasury Buildings  
 consequent upon the reorganisation of the accommodation, and such other works as  
 may be required.
