Act No. 1, 1978.

An Act to repeal the Bankruptcy Act, 1898, and the Bankruptcy (Amendment) Act, 1947; and to enact provisions consequential on the repeal. [Assented to, 20th February, 1978.]

Bankruptcy (Repeal).

BE it enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the “Bankruptcy (Repeal) Act, 1978”.

Repeal of Act No. 25, 1898, and Act No. 7, 1947.

2. (1) The Bankruptcy Act, 1898, is repealed.

(2) The Bankruptcy (Amendment) Act, 1947, is repealed.

Payment into Consolidated Revenue Fund.

3. All money standing immediately before the repeal of the Bankruptcy Act, 1898, to the credit of the Bankruptcy Suitors’ Fund established under that Act shall be paid into the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Saving.

4. (1) The repeal of the Bankruptcy Act, 1898, does not affect the proof of any past act or thing.

(2) This section does not limit any saving in the Interpretation Act, 1897.
