Act No. 72, 1973.

An Act to increase the allowable rebate of rates to certain classes of pensioners and to enable the Broken Hill Water Board to vary those rebates by a by-law; for these purposes to amend the Broken Hill Water and Sewerage Act, 1938; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 20th December, 1973.]

BE

Broken Hill Water and Sewerage (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 72, 1973
 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
 Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Broken Hill Water and Sewerage (Amendment) Act, 1973". Short title.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st January, 1973. Commencement.

3. The Broken Hill Water and Sewerage Act, 1938, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 20, 1938.

(a) by omitting from sections 87A (4) (a) (i), 87A (4) (b) (i), 87A (6) (a) (i) and 87A (6) (b) (i) the words "eighty dollars" wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter "\$120"; Sec. 87A. (Reduction of rates payable by certain classes of pensioners.)

(b) by omitting from sections 87A (4) (a) (ii), 87A (4) (b) (ii), 87A (6) (a) (ii) and 87A (6) (b) (ii) the words "forty dollars" wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter "\$60";

(c) by inserting next after section 87A (15) the following new subsection:—

(16) The amount by which a rate is to be reduced in accordance with subsection (4) or (6) may be varied from time to time by the by-laws and the amount as so varied shall be read as the amount stated in subsection (4) or (6), as the case may be.
