

**BROKEN HILL WATER SUPPLY
(VALIDATION) ACT.**

Act No. 29, 1927.

An Act to validate the carrying out of works and to authorise an expenditure in excess of that authorised by the Broken Hill (Umberumberka Creek) Water Supply Act, 1910. [Assented to, 7th March, 1927.] George V,

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Broken Hill Water Supply (Validation) Act, 1927.” Short title.

2. The carrying out of works designed to extend and augment the supply of water for the city and district of Broken Hill, and the expenditure thereon of sums of eighty-four thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven pounds, and the proposed expenditure of sixty-eight thousand and eight pounds, in excess of the amount authorised by the Broken Hill (Umberumberka Creek) Water Supply Act, 1910, is hereby validated.
