Act No. 21, 1902.

An Act to enable the Borough of Drummoyne Borough of Drummoyne Loan to borrow a sum of £14,000 to pay off certain loans, and for other purposes incidental [11th July, 1902.] thereto.

ENABLING.

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Borough of Drummoyne Loan Short title. Enabling Act, 1902."

2. The several loans mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall, Loans mentioned in notwithstanding that they were raised by municipalities other than the Schedule to be valid. Borough of Drummoyne as at present constituted, be deemed, for all borrow £14,000. purposes of this Act and of the Municipalities Act, 1897, to have been raised by the said borough, and shall, notwithstanding any informality or illegality there may have been in the raising thereof, be for all the purposes aforesaid good and valid loans; and for the purpose of repaying the same and certain interest and expenses now due and owing in respect thereof it shall be lawful for the said borough to borrow the sum of fourteen thousand pounds upon the securities authorised by the Municipalities Act, 1897.
