

## CO-OPERATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to amend the Co-operation Act, 1923-1932, in certain respects; to validate certain payments; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd April, 1935.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Co-operation (Amendment) Act, 1935."

(2) The Co-operation Act, 1923-1932, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Co-operation Act, 1923-1935.

**2.** The Co-operation Act, 1923-1932, is amended by inserting next after section forty-eight the following new section:—

Contribu-

rural  
societies.

48A. A rural society shall have and shall be deemed always to have had power to make contributions out of its funds to any organisation or body, corporate or unincorporate, formed for the purpose of rendering services to or otherwise promoting the interests of rural industry or of improving the conditions of rural life.
