

CO-OPERATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 44, 1941.

George VI. An Act to amend the Co-operation Act, 1923-1938,
No. 44, 1941. as amended by subsequent Acts, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th October, 1941.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Co-operation (Amendment) Act, 1941."

Amendment of Act No. 1, 1924. **2.** (1) The Co-operation Act, 1923-1938, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended—

Sec. 17A. (a) (i) by omitting from paragraph (c) of subsection one of section 17A the words "one hundred pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred and ten pounds";

(Indemnity agreements.)

(ii) by omitting from the same paragraph the words "nine hundred pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand pounds";

(Co-operative Building Advisory Committee.)

(b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection one of section 114A the word "five" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "six."

(2) The amendments made by paragraph (a) of subsection one of this section shall extend to all agreements entered into under section 17A of the Co-operation Act, 1923-1938, as amended by subsequent Acts, before the commencement of this Act (but only in respect of advances made to members after such commencement) notwithstanding anything therein contained; and the obligations of the Colonial Treasurer under any such agreement shall be varied accordingly; but no such variation shall operate to increase the limit of the Colonial Treasurer's liability as stated in the agreement.
