CENSUS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 29, 1946.

An Act to discontinue the publication of George VI. certain census forms in the Government Gazette; for this purpose to amend the Census Act, 1901; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th April, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Census (Amend-Short ment) Act, 1946."

2. The Census Act, 1901, is amended—

(c) by omitting from section seventeen the words Sec. 17. "and after approval by the Minister shall be from published in the Gazette" and by inserting in banking, insurance lieu thereof the words "and approved by the and other companies.) Minister."
