An Act to repeal the proviso to section 7 of the Constitution Act, 1902. [Reserved, 3rd April, 1978. Assent proclaimed, 2nd August, 1978.]

Constitution (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution (Amendment) Short title. Act, 1978".

2. The Constitution Act, 1902, is amended by omitting the proviso to section 7.
