An Act to substitute section 10A of the Co-operation Act, 1923, as a consequence of the enactment of the Fisheries and Oyster Farms (Amendment) Act, 1979. [Assented to, 18th May, 1979.]

Co-operation (Fisheries and Oyster Farms) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Co-operation (Fisheries and Oyster Farms) Amendment Act, 1979".

Commence- **2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day on which Schedule 4 (37) to the Fisheries and Oyster Farms (Amendment) Act, 1979, commences.

Amendment **3.** The Co-operation Act, 1923, is amended by omitting
