## No. V.

An Act to apply certain Sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales towards the Services of the Years 1885 and 1886 and for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [28th May, 1886.]

CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND (No. 5).

HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled have resolved to grant to your Majesty the sum of One million five hundred and thirty-three thousand three hundred and sixty-seven pounds that is to say—

The sum of Five hundred and sixty-seven thousand pounds being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the Colony for the month of May or following month of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six And

The sum of Nine hundred and sixty-six thousand three hundred and sixty-seven pounds for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales £1,533,367 may be there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good issued out of the the supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty for the said several Revenue Fund. Services the sum of One million five hundred and thirty-three thousand three hundred and sixty-seven pounds of which the sum of Five hundred

and sixty-seven thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five inclusive of the annual increases on salaries for that year provided for by the "Civil Service Act of 1884" subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six and Nine hundred and sixty-six thousand three hundred and sixty-seven pounds for the Services specified in the Schedule hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer shall from time to time order and direct And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
