Colonial Spirits. An Act to continue an Act intituled "An Act to " authorize and regulate for a limited time the "warehousing under bond and the exportation "free of duty of Spirits distilled within the "Colony of New South Wales." [15th June, 1848.]

Preamble. 10 Vic. No. 13.

HEREAS by an Act passed in the tenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria and intituled "An Act to "authorize and regulate for a limited time the warehousing under "bond and the exportation free of duty of Spirits distilled within the "Colony of New South Wales" it was amongst other things enacted that the said Act should commence and take effect from and after the passing thereof and should continue in force for two years thereafter and no longer And whereas it is expedient that the duration of the said Act should be extended Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Continued until 31st Legislative Council thereof That the duration of the said Act shall be extended and that the same shall continue in force until the thirtyfirst day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two.
