

CHILD WELFARE (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 9, 1956.

Elizabeth II, No. 9, 1956. An Act to make certain provisions consequent upon the allocation of the administration of certain Acts to the Minister for Child Welfare; for this purpose to amend the Child Welfare Act, 1939, and the Public Instruction (Amendment) Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 17th August, 1956.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Child Welfare (Amendment) Act, 1956."

(2) The Child Welfare Act, 1939, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Child Welfare Act, 1939-1956.

(3) The Public Instruction (Amendment) Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Public Instruction (Amendment) Act, 1916-1956.
