

DARVALL-STREET BRIDGE REMOVAL ACT.

Act No. 4, 1916.

George V. An Act to extinguish any right-of-way over the
No. 4. Darvall-street Bridge at Newcastle and its
approaches; to provide for the removal of the
said bridge and approaches; and for purposes
consequent thereon or incidental thereto.
[Assented to, 23rd March, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Removal of
bridge.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Darvall-street
Bridge Removal Act, 1916."

Short title.

2. Any right-of-way over the Darvall-street Bridge
and its approaches is extinguished, and the Minister for
Public Works may remove in such manner as he may
think proper the said bridge and approaches as described
in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that bridge constructed of timber on timber piles, extending in a
westerly direction from the western end of Darvall-street, in the
municipality of Carrington, across Throsby Creek to the municipality
of Wickham, together with the roadways and embanked approaches
to the bridge, situated in the municipalities of Carrington and
Wickham, parish of Newcastle, and county of Northumberland.
