An Act to increase the maximum sum which is to be contributed annually to the New South Wales Dried Fruits Board by the person in whose name a packing house is registered under the Dried Fruits Act, 1939. [Assented to, 4th April, 1975.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 7, 1975 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Dried Fruits Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1975".
- 2. The Dried Fruits Act, 1939, is amended by omitting Amendment from section 15 (4) the words "five ninety-sixths of a cent of Act No. 7, 1939. per pound" and by inserting instead the words "four dollars Sec. 15. per tonne".
