An Act to extend the period during which the George v. Flour Acquisition Act, 1931, as amended by No. 70, 1931. the Flour Acquisition (Amendment) Act, 1931, is to remain in force; for that purpose to further amend the Flour Acquisition Act, 1931; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th December, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- (2) This Act shall be read and construed with the Flour Acquisition Act, 1931, as amended by the Flour Acquisition (Amendment) Act, 1931. The Flour Acquisition Act, 1931, as so amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
