No. 28, 1945.**

An Act to extend for a further period certain provisions of the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932-1943; to validate certain matters; for these purposes to amend the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932-1943; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 22nd October, 1945.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**Short title,
citation,
and com-
mencement.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Farmers' Relief (Amendment) Act, 1945."

(2) The Farmers' Relief Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts, and by this Act, may be cited as the "Farmers' Relief Act, 1932-1945."

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
