Act No. 14, 1913.

An Act to amend the Friendly Societies (Amendment) Act, 1912. [15th October, 1913.]

FRIENDLY SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT).

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “Friendly Societies (Amendment) Act, 1913.” Short title.

**2.** Section two of the Friendly Societies (Amendment) Act, 1912, is repealed. Repeal of s. 2.

**3.** Section three of the same Act is amended as follows:— Amendment of s. 3.

(a) Omit “Section seven of the same Act” insert “Section thirty-one of the Friendly Societies Act, 1912”

(b) After “may” insert “notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-eight”

**4.** The title to the same Act is amended by omitting “Friendly Societies (Amendment) Act, 1906” and inserting “Friendly Societies Act, 1912” Amendment of title.
