WAGGA RE-ADJUST-  
MENT.

### An Act to provide for the re-adjustment of a portion of the building-line of Fitzmaurice-street in the town of South Wagga Wagga. [3rd June, 1871.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient that the building-line of a portion of Fitzmaurice-street in the Town of South Wagga Wagga should be re-adjusted and that in order to carry out such re-adjustment a portion of the said street should be resumed by the Crown Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Resumption by the Crown of certain land portion of Fitzmaurice-street Town of South Wagga Wagga.

1. After the passing of this Act the strip of land being portion of Fitzmaurice-street in the Town of South Wagga Wagga described in the Schedule hereto shall absolutely free from all rights-of-way street frontage or other easement or right whatsoever be resumed by and re-vested in Her Majesty Her Heirs and Successors And shall thereupon upon such terms and conditions and in such proportions as the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council shall deem just and reasonable be dedicated or alienated as the case may be to the several parties entitled to street frontage along the said portion of Fitzmaurice-street.

#### SCHEDULE.

*DESCRIPTION of a strip of land portion of Fitzmaurice-street in the Town of South Wagga Wagga Parish of South Wagga Wagga County of Wynyard:—*

Commencing at a point in the south-eastern side of Johnston-street bearing north sixty degrees east and distant two chains and sixty links from the northern corner of allotment number two of section thirty-eight being the northern corner of portion number one of that section appropriated for a School of Arts and bounded thence on the north-west by the north-easterly prolongation of the south-eastern side of Johnston-street bearing north sixty degrees east fifty links on the north-east by a line parallel with Fitzmaurice-street bearing south thirty degrees east three chains and ninety-three links on the east by a line bearing south one chain to the eastern corner of portion three of two roods twenty-six perches and on the south-west by the north-eastern boundaries of that portion and portion one bearing north thirty degrees west four chains and eighty links to the point of commencement.
