Act No. 8, 1977.

An Act to amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, in relation to the days on which certain meetings for horse-racing may be held. [Assented to, 11th March, 1977.]

BE

Gaming and Betting (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting Short
(Amendment) Act, 1977". title.

2. The Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, is amended by inserting after section 53 (4) the following subsection :—

(5) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a meeting meetings.)
for horse-racing may be held—

(a) at Canterbury Race-course on Monday 14th
March, 1977; and

(b) at Rosehill Race-course on Monday 16th
May, 1977,

but nothing in this subsection shall be construed as increasing the maximum number of days on which meetings for horse-racing may be held at those race-courses in 1977.

3. If the date of assent to this Act is later than 14th March, 1977, section 53 (5) of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, as amended by this Act, shall be deemed to have commenced on 14th March, 1977.
