

GAS AND ELECTRICITY
(FURTHER AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 51, 1936.

An Act to amend the Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1936, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th December, 1936.] Edward VIII,
No. 51, 1936.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Gas and Electricity (Further Amendment) Act, 1936."

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the eleventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

2. The Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1936, is amended by omitting from subsection five of section sixty-six the words "or the charges and fees to be imposed".
