GOVERNOR'S AND
JUDGES' SALARIES.

An Act to provide for the payment of the Salaries of the Governor of New South Wales and the Judges of the Supreme Court thereof out of the Revenues of the Customs of the said Colony. [3rd February, 1832.]

Preamble. **W**HEREAS it is expedient to make some certain provision for the payment of the salaries of the Governor or Acting Governor for the time-being of this Colony and of the Chief Justice and Judges of the Supreme Court Be it therefore enacted by the Governor by and with the advice of the Legislative Council That from and after the passing of this Act the salaries hereinafter mentioned respectively payable to the Governor of this Colony or the Acting Governor for the time-being and to the Chief Justice and Judges of the Supreme Court shall be a charge upon and be paid out of the Revenues arising from the Duties of Customs levied in this Colony.

2. And be it further enacted That the Treasurer of this Colony shall and do henceforth pay to the Governor or the Acting Governor for

Customs.

for the time-being the sum of five thousand pounds sterling and to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court the sum of two thousand pounds sterling and to each of the Puisne Judges of the said Court the sum of fifteen hundred pounds sterling upon such days times and periods in each and every year as the Governor or the Acting Governor for the time-being by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him shall from time to time order and direct and that the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Revenues received from the Customs payable in this Colony.

3. And be it further enacted That the said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums so paid by him to the Governor or Acting Governor for the time-being and to the Chief Justice and other Judges of the Supreme Court not exceeding for any one year the sums hereinbefore mentioned and that the receipt or receipts of such Governor or Acting Governor for the time-being and of the Chief Justice and other Judges of the Supreme Court shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums of money as shall be therein mentioned and that he shall and do receive credit for the same accordingly.
