GENERAL LOAN ACCOUNT APPROPRIATION ACT.

Act No. 30, 1954.

RIEDER II, An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 18th November, 1954.]

Preamble. W HEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its seventy-second meeting held on the twenty-ninth and thirtieth days of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act. 1944, that the amount to be borrowed

borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth No. 30, 1954. and the States for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, shall be two hundred million pounds, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of fifty-two million eight hundred thousand pounds to the State of New South Wales, BE it enacted therefore by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Loan Short title. Account Appropriation Act, 1954."
- 2. The sum of sixty-two million six hundred and Appropriate thirty-two thousand pounds is hereby appropriated from ton from General Loan Account for the public works and Loan services hereunder set out, and shall, as required be Account. applied as follows:—
