GENERAL LOAN ACCOUNT APPROPRIATION ACT.

Act No. 51, 1964.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain Elizabeth II, sum out of the General Loan Account and for No. 51, 1964 the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th December, 1964.]

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its eighty-ninth Preamble. meeting held on the second day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, shall be two hundred and ninety million pounds, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of seventy-four million seven hundred and thirty-five thousand pounds to the State of New South Wales for public works, BE it enacted therefore by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—
