Act No. 68, 1969.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of part of that sum for certain Public Works and Services and for the transfer of part of that sum to the Consolidated Revenue Fund in reduction of part of the accumulated deficit in that Fund; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 27th November, 1969.]

WHEREAS

HEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its ninety-sixth No. 68, 1969
meeting held on the twenty-sixth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, decided in pursuance of Clause 3
(9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy, shall be seven hundred and fifty-eight million dollars, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of one hundred and ninety-four million five hundred and ninety thousand dollars to the State of New South Wales, BE it enacted therefore by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Loan Account Short title. Appropriation Act, 1969".
- 2. The sum of two hundred and forty-five million four Appropriation hundred and twenty-eight thousand dollars is hereby appropriated tion from from the General Loan Account for the public works and services hereunder set out, and shall, as required, be applied as follows:— Account.
