Act No. 13, 1968.

An Act to make provision for an increase in the salary of the Governor of New South Wales; for this purpose to amend the Governor's Salary Act, 1901, and the Constitution Act, 1902, as subsequently amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Reserved, 26th April, 1968. Assented to, 7th June, 1968.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Governor's Salary Short title, citation and commencement.

- (2) The Governor's Salary Act, 1901, as subsequently amended and as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Governor's Salary Act, 1901-1968.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and sixtyeight.
