An Act to amend the Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1938, consequentially upon the enactment of the Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Act, 1979. [Assented to, 9th May, 1979.]

Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage (Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Hunter District Wat, Short title. Sewerage and Drainage (Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers) Amendment Act, 1979".
- 2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall Commencecommence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Section 3 shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (3) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Act, 1979.
- 3. The Hunter District Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, Amendment of Act No. 11, 1938. 1938, is amended—
 - (a) by omitting section 46 and by inserting instead the Sec. 46. following section:-
 - 46. (1) No person shall commence or perform work Prohibition of any class or description in connection with water on carrying out supply, sewerage or drainage which communicates or is certain intended to communicate directly or indirectly with the work except by pipes, sewers or drains of the board unless—

holders of licences,

(a) he is the holder of a licence or certificate of etc. registration granted under the Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainers Act, 1979, of a class prescribed in relation to work of that class or description; or

- (b) he does so under the immediate supervision of the holder of a licence of a class prescribed in relation to work of that class or description.
- (2) Any person who acts or knowingly employs another to act in contravention of subsection (1) is guilty of an offence under this Act and is liable upon summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$2,000.
- (b) by omitting section 128 (1) (v).
